- Which of the eight pillars' questions did you find most difficult to answer? Were the difficulties due to a lack of information, to a reluctance in acknowledging your current reality, or something else?
- For each of the eight pillars, if you scored:
  - Between 12 and 15  
You are doing very well in this area, and no immediate action is required. Feel free to look at the resources offered in the Learning Commons in this pillar as interest arises or time permits.
  - Between 8 and 11  
You are doing relatively well in this area. Once more urgent topics are addressed, return to the Introductory Module of this pillar to see what it might have to offer.
  - Less than 7  
Make this pillar an urgent priority for your community by beginning with its Introductory Module.
